In addition, the program oversees: Nutrition Snack, Breakfast Club, Emergency Lunch, Snack in the Shack, Collective Kitchen, Young Chefs and Community Garden.

This position requires a highly motivated and committed individual. The primary focus in this challenging role is working in a team setting in order to successfully deliver the program to children at Prince Charles School.

Duties: setting up lunch area, receiving food, serving children, cleaning, administrative duties, and other duties as required.

Hours: 3 to 4 hours each school day, weekdays except Thursday.
